



Now Nineveh was an exceedingly large city, a three days' walk across. ⁴Jonah began to go into the city, going a day's walk. And he cried out, "Forty days more, and Nineveh shall be overthrown!" ⁵And the people of Nineveh believed God; they proclaimed a fast, and everyone, great and small, put on sackcloth.

¹⁰When God saw what they did, how they turned from their evil ways, God changed his mind about the calamity that he had said he would bring upon them; and he did not do it.

¹¹God has spoken once, twice have I heard it, that power belongs to God.


¹²Steadfast love belongs to you, O Lord, for you repay all according to their deeds.

SERMON

NICENE CREED

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth. of all that is, seen and unseen. EUCHARISTIC PRAYER


LORD'S PRAYER

Now may the body and blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ strengthen you and keep you in God's grace.


PRAYER AFTER COMMUNION


